For Methodists, Ash Wednesday marks the start of Lent, a period of reflection and repentance, where the placement of ashes on the forehead symbolizes the recognition of one's mortality and sinfulness, signifying a call to turn back to God and prepare for Easter through prayer, fasting, and acts of charity; the ashes are traditionally made from burning the previous year's Palm Sunday palm branches, representing the cycle of death and resurrection.
